- Year 5 and 6 - Mrs Gibbs (Upper KS2 leader), Mrs Purllant and Miss Ridgwell / Mrs Parolin



My role as Executive Headteacher will continue until the end of the Autumn term, therefore Mrs Wood will not have a teaching commitment in order to lead the school in my absence.
