The Elite Player Development Centre forms the top tier of our provision and training will take place at Whitton Sports Centre in Ipswich.

The programme includes:

- 30 weeks of 2hr training sessions, on 3G pitches.
- Minimum of 4 competitive fixtures across the season against the likes of Cambridge United, Reading & Peterborough United.
- Tours, festivals and tournaments.
- Two player progress reports a season.
