Topic: Me, Myself and I

It has been an action packed week full of introductions and getting to know each other. The children have settled amazingly well and are gelling into two adorable classes!

Communication, Language and Literacy

We read Goldilocks and the Three Bears. We spoke about feelings within the story and discussed how poor Baby Bear felt at the end of the tale and how Goldilocks felt when she saw the three bears after her sleep.

We also shared our 'All About Me Boxes' too. The children were so excited to do this. They equally enjoyed looking through their friends boxes too. It really was an excellent, visual way of finding out about everyone. Any boxes which didn't come in this week can be brought in whenever they are ready. Thank you, for all of the effort that went into these.

Physical Development

We used scissors to cut around the edges of scrap pieces of paper. Some of the children turned these into tickets to sell. What a clever idea!

Mathematics

Our focus this week was using our fingers to represent numbers in songs. We sang 'Five Little Men in a Flying Saucer' and 'Five Little Speckled Frogs'.
